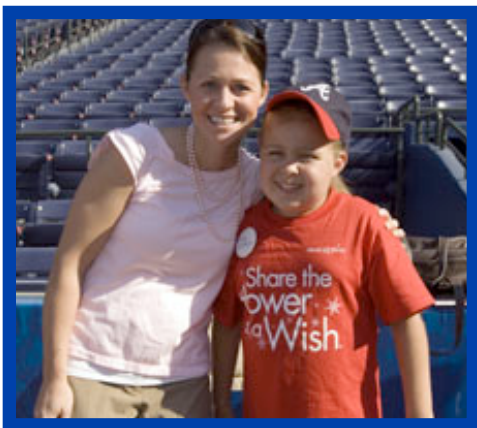

CHARITABLE INVOLVEMENT

- Tim and his wife Kim are ambassadors for the Make-A-Wish Foundation, and throughout the baseball season, fulfill children's wishes to visit Turner Field and meet Braves players.
- Kim is a member of the Board of Directors of the Make-A-Wish Foundation of Georgia and Alabama.
- Tim and Kim are honorary co-chairs of the annual Celebration of Wishes Gala, and Kim is on the Auction Committee involved in securing auction items for the event.
- Each December, Tim and Kim invite children from the Make-A-Wish Foundation to participate in a shopping spree and holiday party at Toys R Us. Each Make-A-Wish child and their sibling receives a Toys R Us gift card courtesy of the Hudson family.
- Tim and Kim work tirelessly to support Children's Healthcare of Atlanta Pediatric Hospital. Each spring training they host the Tim Hudson Birdies & Baseball Celebrity Amateur golf tournament, and in August, Tim joins forces with his Braves teammates to host the annual Braves Celebrity Am Golf Tournament to benefit Children's Healthcare of Atlanta.
- Tim and Kim have joined forces with The Moyer Foundation to support Camp Erin, a bereavement camp designed for children ages 6-17 who have experienced the death of a parent, friend or loved one. The campaign seeks to bring Camp Erin to every MLB city, and the Hudsons have had an instrumental role in helping to raise awareness about the program and spearheading the effort to establish Camp Erin Atlanta.
- In 2008, Tim was honored for the third straight year as the Atlanta Braves recipient of the Roberto Clemente Award that recognizes those players who best exemplify the game of baseball through sportsmanship, community involvement, and positive contributions to their teams.
- In addition to the work of his own Foundation, Tim continues to support the work of the Atlanta Braves Foundation and their community programs and fundraisers.
- Each season Tim and Kim purchase fifteen season tickets for the Braves "Reach Out, Be Our Guest" program and donate their tickets to youth serving organizations throughout Georgia and Alabama.
